Feed to growing and breeding rabbits. Feed requirements depend on the size, breed, and stage of growth, use or production.

TYPE OF RABBIT	DAILY FEEDING REQUIREMENTS
Bucks	80gm to 150gm
Resting Does	120gm to 175gm
Does During Gestation	150gm to 200gm
*Nursing Does 1st 3 weeks	200gm to 350gm
*Nursing Does 3 weeks to weaning	450gm to 700gm
**Growing Rabbits	50gm to 100gm

\* Self feed the doe during this period.

\*\* For young rabbits, we suggest self feeding for most economical gains.

120gm to 200gm.

*Lactating Does:* Free Choice, first day after kindling feed  
60gm to 120gm. Increase daily to reach  
free-choice feeding in 4 to 5 days.

*Weaned Rabbits:* Feed free-choice with hay.

**NOTE:** These feeding directions are for medium sized breeds. Adjust for smaller or larger breeds. Provide plenty of clean, fresh water at all times. Surroundings should be kept clean and free of dirt and parasites.
